Thank You for Helping Us to Help Others!

Helping Kids Communicate

Semajay, age 11, has Cerebral Palsy and has difficulty with communicating. His occupational therapist requested and received an i-Pad with a special application to assist with communication and foster independence.

Josiah, age 3, has hearing loss and the foundation purchased a Roger Mike for him to use at home to be able to clearly hear his parents. **Alexia**, age 9, received hearing aids.

Keeping Kids Healthy (and Happy)

Asher receives his nutrition through a g-tube and the family requested assistance with purchasing specialized blended food. The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation was able to provide three months of nutrition during a difficult time for the family.

Nutritional support was also provided for **Samir**, age 6, who has Neurofibromatosis Type 1; **Shawn**, age 1, who has Holoprosencephaly; and **Mohamas**, age 9, who has Spastic Quadriplegia Cerebral Palsy.

Keeping Kids on the Move

As their children get older and grow, families have increasing difficulty carrying their children up and down the stairs to enter and exit their home. Thanks to you, our wonderful supporters, the following kids received accessibility ramps: **Prevnav**, age 10, who has Cerebral Palsy; **Hussein**, age 13, who has Cerebral Palsy; **Francis**, age 16, who has Muscular Dystrophy; and **Gideon**, age 7, who is paralyzed.

Deangelo, age 6 and **Leo**, age 5, both needed more support to assist with walking and their therapist contacted the foundation to request special suits called Theratogs. Again, the foundation was able to grant these requests.

Morgan, age 8, who has Cerebral Palsy and seizures, received a Taos Orthotic to maintain proper alignment which assists with walking.

Keeping Kids on the Move (cont.)

Every year, we receive many calls from therapists and teachers telling us their students enjoy riding adaptive tricycles at school and therapy while at the same time receiving wonderful health benefits such as strengthening muscles, increasing range of motion of joints and a feeling of accomplishment—all while playing. Thanks to Rifton Equipment who gives our foundation a huge discount on every bike we purchase. Thanks also to you! Because of your generous donations, the following kids received adaptive tricycles of their own: **Lucian**, age 6, who has Down Syndrome; **Lester**; **Carson**; **Preston**, age 3, who has Pelizaeus Mertzbacher Type 2 Leukodystrophy; **Noah**, age 13, who has Autism; **Emma**, age 7, who has Kabuki Syndrome, Epilepsy and Autism; **Alexander**, age 11, who has Cerebral Palsy; **Luke**, age 5, who has Cerebral Palsy; **Timothy**, age 16, who has Cerebral Palsy; **Elijah**, age 6, who has Hemiplegia due to a brain hemorrhage at birth; and **Matthew**, age 6 who has Spina Bifida.

The foundation also purchased two adaptive tricycles to be used at Bovensch Special Ed. They had a limited number of bikes and many kids who want to ride.

The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation will occasionally receive requests for the purchase of a double stroller for kids who are dependent on a ventilator to breathe. **Morgan**, age 1 who has Bronchopulmonary Dysplasia and Pulmonary Hypertension as well as **Annabelle** and **Addyson**, age 4, who have Leigh's Disease received strollers.

Ezra, age 5, had encephalopathy and his therapist requested a scooter chair to assist with his mobility. The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation was happy to provide this for Ezra.

Mason, age 3, has Cerebral Palsy and is blind. His family worked with multiple foundations to purchase a wheelchair accessible van. The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation was happy to be a part of this purchase.

Ghazali, age 5, has Congenital Myopathy. Ghazali's therapist contacted us to see if we could purchase a wheelchair for her. Because of our wonderful donors, we were able to say yes to this request.

Makenzie, age 5, has Cerebral Palsy and Dandy Walker Syndrome. **Kendric**, age 3, suffered from anoxic brain injury at birth. **Scarlet**, age 1, has Epilepsy. All three received adaptive strollers from the Emily Ann Griffin Foundation.

Adaptive strollers are expensive and occasionally need new parts. The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation purchased replacement parts for **Harper**, age 2 and **Sophie**, age 4.

Kanye, age 8, suffers from kidney failure. The family needed some minor car repairs that they were not able to afford. It is imperative that Kanye be able to attend his medical appointments, so The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation paid for the car repairs.

Naomi has Cerebral Palsy and is unable to stand or walk without assistance. She was using a Rabbit Walker at therapy with great success. Naomi's therapist contacted the foundation to see if it was possible to get a Rabbit Walker for Naomi to use at home. Yes, it was possible thanks to your donations!

Keeping Kids Safe

Bathing kids with special needs can be a challenge as they get older and are too big for a bath chair and are not able to sit on their own. Over the past few years, the foundation has had requests for Splashy Seats for their older kids. The foundation has purchased Splashy Seats for the following kids: **Kenneth**, age 4, who has paraplegia; **Anthony**, age 4, who suffered from Hypoxic Ischemic Encephalopathy; and **Ethan**, age 6, who has Lissencephaly and seizures.

A Benik Vest is a tight neoprene suit that provides upper trunk support and proprioceptive input. The foundation has purchased vests for three kids at the request of their therapists—**Zachary**, age 2 who has Spastic Quadriplegia Cerebral Palsy; **Dezayontae**, age 2, who suffered a grade four brain bleed due to prematurity and has resulting hypotonia; and **Hayley**, age 2, who has hypotonia and seizures. Hayley's therapist also requested an activity chair and the Emily Ann Griffin Foundation was able to provide these items.

David, age 2, has sensory issues and is developmentally delayed. The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation purchased a compression vest for him.

Landon, age 2 was diagnosed with Sturge Webber Syndrome. The foundation purchased a floor sitter to aid in sitting up as well as an activity seat.

Emily, age 15, has Cerebral Palsy and Hydrocephalus. Emily's therapist requested a shower chair and the foundation was happy to purchase one for her.



Miaka, age 1, has Emmanuel Syndrome. Miaka's family requested an air filter for the home and a highchair with extra support.

Many children with special needs are not able to sit up on their own and require special devices to assist with sitting on their own. Different kids require a different amount of support. The following kids received special seating devices

ordered especially for their particular needs: **Miracle**, age 5, who has Cerebral Palsy; **Carson**, age 2, who has Tay Sachs Disease; **Hayley**, age 3, who has Cerebral Palsy; and **Aurora**, age 10, who has Spina Bifida.

Children with special needs also have difficulty being safely restrained in an automobile. The Emily Ann Griffin provided **Ethan**, age 7, who has Hypotonic Cerebral Palsy, with special harness supports and **Ellah**, age 8, who has Agenesis of her Corpus Callosum, received an adaptive car seat.

Annika, age 9, was getting too heavy to be lifted in and out of the bathtub. The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation purchased a bath lift for the family.

Keeping Kids Comfortable

Many children with Autism and sensory processing disorders need special sensory tools to help the child overcome their aversions. The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation purchased sensory equipment for the following kids: **Keith**, age 2; **Anthony**, age 2; **Andrew**, age 1; **Alivia**, age 1 and **Symeon**.



Zora, age 14 has Cerebral Palsy and Autism. Her physician requested a weighted blanket to help soothe her when she is upset.

Zoey, age 4, has Sturge Weber Syndrome. Her social worker contacted us to see if we could provide the family with a special Nuna Glider to help comfort her. Her parents were finding it

difficult to soothe her while holding her. The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation was happy to purchase this item for Zoey.

Rowan, age 10, has Epilepsy and difficulty controlling his body temperature. The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation purchased an air conditioning unit to help keep Rowan comfortable and safe during the summer months.

Mohammad, age 9, has Spastic Quadriplegia Cerebral Palsy. Mohammad needed hand splints which the foundation was able to purchase for him.

Darrell, age 10, has Autism. He loves to be active and this is difficult during the winter months. The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation purchased a membership at the local recreation center that offers a safe and socially acceptable place to expend all that energy.

Sending Kids to Camp and Therapy

Ian, age 9, has Autism and is non-verbal. The Emily Ann Griffin Foundation paid for therapy during the summer months.

Destiny, age 14, has Congenital Malformation Syndrome and loves to swing, so the Emily Ann Griffin Foundation purchased her a platform swing to provide hours of fun while sneaking in hours of therapy.

Each summer, the foundation receives requests for assistance so kids with special needs can attend camp. The following kids received assistance: **Darell**, age 10 and **Mohamad**, age 13 who both have Autism; and **Gavin**, age 13 and **Katie** who both have Cerebral Palsy.
